Cultivating with the 4-Row Weeder, inner-row as well as between-row weeds are easily uprooted without disturbing deeper rooted crop plants. The springy action of the Weeder tines also helps to effectively loosen soil and break ground crusts. The large acreage that can be covered in 3rd gear by the Weeder's 160-inch width and its amazing effectiveness in kill-

ing small weeds make the Ferguson Weeder one of the lowest cost and most economical implements on the farm.

Tractor mounted with Ferguson 3-Point, One-Minute Attachment, the Weeder is operated by Finger Tip Hydraulic Control. Attach the implement, lift it to transport position and you can travel at full road speed to the field. Another touch of the Finger Tip Control Lever lowers the implement to working depth.



The Ferguson Weeder uproots weeds, stirs up clods of dirt, breaks soil crust, leaves a light mulch of turned-up weeds.





Effectively used on hilled crops of corn or cotton, the springy action of the tines helps to gradually fill in around the crop.



Ferguson Weeder spring tines remove light-rooted weeds, leaving deeper-rooted row crops undamaged. Action of tines breaks up the soil crust.

Complete hydraulic Finger Tip and automatic depth control assure you of positive soil penetration by every one of the 74 spring-steel tines.

No worry about trash clogging the tines nor difficulty in making turns at the headlands. A touch of the Finger Tip Control Lever raises the Weeder to clear trash or make a short turn at the ends of the rows. Lower the Finger Tip Control Lever and the Weeder returns to working position.

Easy and quick to transport from field to field or along the road, the Ferguson Weeder can be raised for transport by Finger Tip Hydraulic Control. By releasing the lock bar the outer sections of the Weeder may

be folded over the inner sections for gate clearance and ease in storing.

3-POINT ATTACHMENT

With convenient Ferguson 3-Point Attachment the Weeder can be hitched or unhitched in a matter of minutes. You can back the Weeder into your machinery shed, unhitch, attach another implement and start another job in a tenth of the time it used to take to unload similar pull-type implements from a truck or drag.

FLEXIBLE TEETH


Seventy-four, high-carbon, spring-steel teeth are individually clamped in place along the 130-inch frame. They can be set at any

spacing desired. Strong, yet flexible, they effectively remove smaller weeds *in the crop rows* leaving the deeper-rooted crop plants to grow.

The flexing of the teeth also stirs the soil—breaks up smothering crusts and works over the top soil leaving a light mulch of uprooted weeds and trash that helps to maintain good tilth and water-holding capacity.

LIGHTWEIGHT, STURDY FRAME

Constructed of high-strength steel angles, the Weeder frame is easy to handle and with outer sections folded, it can be conveniently stored. A lock bar secures the outer sections in place when operating.



S P E C I F I C A T I O N S

Attachment: One-minute 3-point attachment to the Ferguson Tractor without wrenches or tools.

Control: Complete Finger Tip and Automatic Hydraulic Control of raising, lowering and depth.

Width: 13' 4", cultivates 4 rows of corn, 6 to 8 rows of beets, beans or other vegetable crops. Transport width with ends folded up is 10'.

Adjustment: Teeth may be moved laterally on the frame. Ends easily folded by moving lock bar for transport. Depth adjusted by Finger Tip Control.

Clearance: 17 3/8" under teeth with Weeder raised to transport position.

Teeth: 74 high-carbon, spring-steel teeth—set approximately 2" apart—rounded and pointed for more effective use.

Frame: Lightweight, high-strength steel angles.

End Sections: Strongly reinforced, held rigidly in place by lock bars. Hinged for gate clearance in transport.
